





























Construction Fun Facts

The learning space designs at Sotomayor have been guided by three themes:


- **Collaboration** selecting affordances and furniture that support collaborative learning opportunities where students can easily learn together.
- **Flexibility** selecting affordances and furniture that move easily to support active learning and a variety of classroom layouts.
- **Comfortability** providing various options for work surfaces (desks, tables, & floor space) and seating choices (benches, booths, ottomans, stools, floor pads, & chairs) to support an array of learners, learning styles, and learning needs within the classroom space.








Utilizing District-Approved Curriculum in an Innovative Manner










Spanish Language Dual Immersion (90/10) Model



- Bilingualism and Biliteracy Students develop a high level of thinking, listening, speaking, reading, and writing proficiency in English and the partner language.
- **High Academic Achievement** Students strive for academic excellence in all subject areas, meeting or exceeding Common Core State Standards.
- Socio-Cultural Competence Students develop positive attitudes and appreciation toward world languages and cultures in our global society, promoting their civic involvement.







Spanish Language Dual Immersion (90/10) Model

- Program participation is voluntary. An English only program is available to families.
- Parents must sign a Parent Commitment Form pledging to remain in the Dual Language Program from Kindergarten 6th grade.
- Parents are required to attend required meetings throughout the year.
- Parents understand that combination classes may be created at times.





Special Day Class Mild/Moderate Classrooms and Moderate/Severe Classrooms

- A full continuum of services to eligible students in the least restrictive environment.
- We strive to build a partnership with parents by working collaboratively to develop Individualized Education Programs (IEPs) for children that include services and supports according to their unique needs.
- The school will have flexible and diverse seating to support student learning with lots of light and biophilic elements (nature in the school). Unique spaces are being crafted for all students to support academic and social-emotional well being. Students will still have access to same curricular resources for their program.
- Sonia Sotomayor will maximize mainstreaming opportunities (VAPA, library, recess, and lunch) with access to general education peers as well as other SDC students.





LEAD Program

- CVESD's LEAD Program is a **free program** that offers different enrichment opportunities, including language, robotics, music, sports, and more.
- Students participating in the program learn a new skill and interact with peers in a physically and emotionally safe environment.
- The LEAD Program is free to transitional kindergarten through sixth grade students who meet program requirements.







YMCA Character Builders

- Character Builders program provides **affordable** and dependable childcare to elementary school students **before and after-school.**
- Activities include homework support, health and wellness, visual and performing arts, sports, leadership development, service learning, and character development.
- An affordable program from the South Bay Family YMCA, serves students from TK to Grade 6 at Sonia Sotomayor Elementary School.








Your Involvement is Key to Your Child's Success!
